At the heart of the **SMASH 2000L** is its AI-assisted targeting system that automatically calculates the optimal shooting solution based on parameters such as distance, angle, and target movement. This approach allows soldiers to hit flying targets with a certainty that would not be possible with traditional tools.

The SMASH 2000L has already been successfully tested in numerous countries, including Israel, the United States, India, the United Kingdom, the Netherlands, and Australia. The system has

proven its effectiveness in countering the growing threat of drones, a danger that many armed forces face daily. In addition to improving accuracy, the system supports a wide range of ammunition and can be integrated with **C4I systems** (Command, Control, Communications, Computers, and Intelligence) and **Battle Management Systems**, enhancing overall operational efficiency.

With the signing of significant contracts such as the **13 million dollar** deal for the **Transformation In Contact (TIC) 2.0** program, the SMASH 2000L represents a fundamental step towards the introduction of high-tech warfare solutions on the battlefield. The next step will be the introduction of the **SMASH 3000**, an even more advanced version of the system, which further reduces size and weight and incorporates improved algorithms for target tracking.
