



4th Anti-Aircraft Artillery Regiment Peschiera: a Century of Sky Defense

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Mantua hosted a particularly significant ceremony for the history of the Italian Army: the **centenary of the establishment of the 4th Anti-Aircraft Artillery Regiment “Peschiera”**, a unit founded on **March 11, 1926** and now stationed at **Caserma San Martino**.
