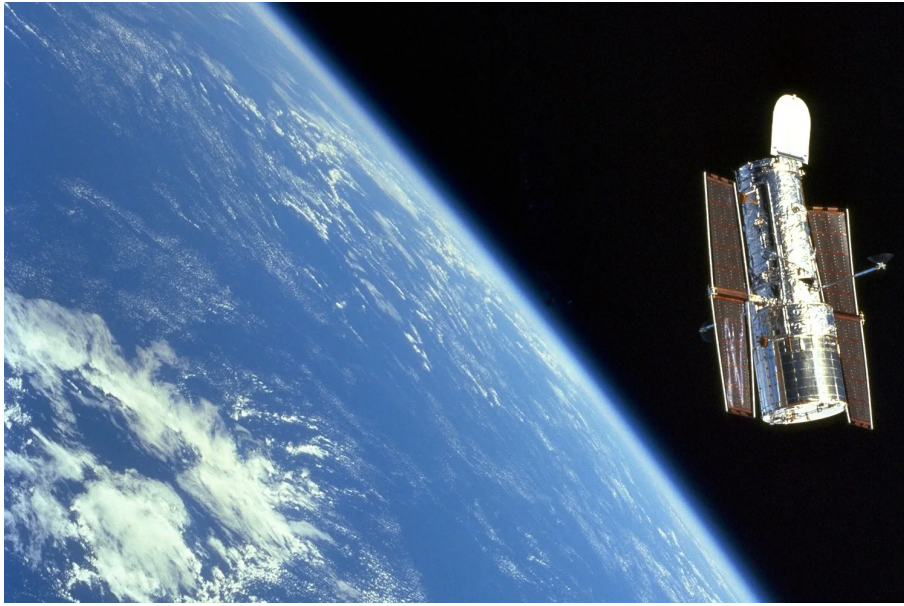




Avino, the Folgore Boy Who Wants Italy to Be a Leader in Space
