



Change of Command at the 183rd Paratroopers Regiment “Nembo”: Col. Alessandro Villa takes over from Col. Francesco Errico

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The change of command ceremony at the 183rd Paratroopers Regiment “Nembo” took place between Colonel **Francesco Errico** and Colonel **Alessandro Villa**. The event, particularly significant for the military and civilian community, was held in the presence of the Commander of the Paratroopers Brigade “Folgore”, **Brigadier General Federico Bernacca**, the **Prefect of Pistoia Dr. Angelo Gallo Carrabba**, the **Mayor Alessandro Tomasi**, and the **Veterans and Arms Associations**.

The Handover

During the solemn review of the units and the flag-raising ceremony, Colonel Errico symbolically handed over the War Flag of the “Nembo” to his successor, sealing the continuity of command
