



Forio Honors the Esercito Italiano with Civic Honors

Honors awarded to Esercito Italiano units and officers for service to the community during emergencies on the island of Ischia

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The Pontifical Basilica of San Vito Martire in Forio hosted a solemn ceremony dedicated to the awarding of Civic Honors, through which the municipal administration recognized the commitment demonstrated by institutions and military personnel in the area.
