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Giovanni Caravelli: The Silent General Leading AISE for Another 2 Years

Army Corps General, Caravelli embodies the figure of the "servant of the State" away from the spotlight, yet central to national security dynamics.

Biography and Education

Born in **Frascati in 1961**, Caravelli has built his entire career on military and strategic excellence.

- **Military Career:** Artillery officer, he climbed the ranks of the Italian Army.

2. **The Pandemic:** During the COVID-19 emergency, external intelligence played a crucial role in procuring medical devices and monitoring geopolitical dynamics related to vaccines.
3. **The Ukrainian Conflict:** Since the beginning of the Russian invasion in 2022, Caravelli has ensured a constant flow of information to protect Italian interests and coordinate the response with NATO partners.
