



High-level performance by the Paratroopers of the "Savoia Cavalleria" Regiment (3rd) in the United Kingdom at the “Cambrian Patrol”

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The “Cambrian Patrol”, one of the most prestigious military competitions at an international level, hosted by the headquarters of the 160th (Welsh) Brigade in Wales, United Kingdom, has recently concluded. The Italian Army achieved an excellent result, with the ["Savoia Cavalleria" Regiment \(3rd\)](#) winning the silver medal, once again demonstrating its ability to excel in highly competitive contexts. The event was also attended by the [152nd Infantry Regiment "Sassari"](#), confirming Italy's solidity on the international stage.

The “Cambrian Patrol” is an annual event involving 111 patrols, 39 of which come from

Along the route, the patrols are tested on a series of tactical and technical tasks: from reacting to CBRN (Chemical, Biological, Radiological, and Nuclear) threats to treating casualties, recognizing enemy vehicles, mine clearance, defending against enemy drones (UAS), and

crossing fords, culminating in a team attack. These scenarios simulate real operational conditions, requiring not only physical strength and endurance but also mental readiness and the ability to react in dynamic contexts.

Before the competition, the personnel of the "Savoia Cavalleria" participated in intensive training together with the 1st The Queen's Dragoon Guards (QDG), one of the most prestigious cavalry units of the British Army. This cooperation was essential to refine the specific techniques and operational procedures of the competition, allowing the Italian paratrooper cavalrymen to integrate perfectly with their British comrades. The quick learning and professionalism demonstrated by the "Savoia" aroused great admiration among the English personnel, highlighting the effectiveness of the joint training.
