



Iran Massacre: How the USA Will Attack

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While the [Iranian regime drowns the street protests in blood](#), the White House is preparing moves that could change the face of the Middle East. Donald Trump, with the American military by his side, is considering "very concrete options" to respond to the brutal repression. The world watches with bated breath: will this be the beginning of the "decapitation of the serpent"?

Washington's Strategic Choice: From Mediation to the Role of "Resolver"

The Tuesday summit at the White House, which will bring together President Donald Trump with Secretary of State Marco Rubio, Pentagon chief Pete Hegseth, and General Dan Caine, is not a mere consultation. It is the turning point of a strategy that abandons classic interventionism to embrace a more direct and audacious approach. Trump's words, "*it seems they are starting to do it*", referring to crossing the "red line" with the killing of protesters, mark the beginning of a new phase.

The brutal repression in Iran, with a toll that according to some opposition sources and the Mohammadi Nobel Foundation has reached **2,000 dead in the last 48 hours**, has provided Washington with the pretext to consider an intervention that goes well beyond economic sanctions. The Trump administration does not aim for slow and costly "nation-building" but to act as a **geopolitical resolver**: an actor that intervenes to cut the threat at its root, aiming for the "decapitation" of a hostile regime through swift, precise, and lethal strikes.

The options on the table, studied in detail by the Pentagon, do not foresee a ground invasion but a series of coordinated actions to paralyze the regime's ability to resist.

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The Tools of Intervention: Technical-Military Options on the Table

The meeting at the White House will serve to present the President with a range of interventions based on the most advanced technologies and rapid force projection.

1. Kinetic Operations: "Precision Strike" and Decapitation

The Pentagon is refining plans for targeted attacks aimed at paralyzing the regime without deploying massive ground troops:

- **Strikes on Pasdaran infrastructure:** The primary target is the bases of the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) and command and control centers. The aim would be to disrupt the command chain of the Basij, responsible for charges against civilians.
- **Stealth Assets and Tomahawks:** The use of **Tomahawk** cruise missiles launched from submarines, combined with sorties of stealth bombers **B-21 Raider** or **B-2 Spirit**, to destroy Iranian radar systems. This would allow "blinding" the regime before any other move.
- **Drone Neutralization:** Surgical destruction of **Shahed** production sites, eliminating the main Iranian asymmetric threat in the region.

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2. Electronic Warfare and Cyber-Warfare

This option allows striking while remaining "invisible," neutralizing the regime's repressive capacity from within:

- **Sabotage of security networks:** Infiltration of encrypted communication systems used by militias to coordinate massacres in the squares.
- **Selective Blackouts:** Targeted hacker attacks to cut off power in power centers and prisons, facilitating potential internal revolts or escapes of political prisoners.
- **Internet Support (Starlink):** Massive deployment of Starlink terminals to bypass the network blockade imposed by Tehran. This technical tool is considered essential to allow the population to organize and spread evidence of atrocities in real-time.

3. Tactical Support and Psychological Warfare

The USA could act as a "force multiplier" for internal resistance and regular armed forces (**Artesh**) pushed to defection:

- **Real-Time Intelligence:** Sharing satellite data and interceptions with opposition groups to allow them to anticipate Pasdaran moves.
- **Psychological Operations:** Targeted information campaigns to convince regular army soldiers not to shoot their brothers, promising immunity and a role in the future post-regime order.

4. Defense of Regional Assets

Since Iran has threatened to strike Israel and American bases, the plan includes a strong defensive component:

- **Anti-Missile Shield:** Strengthening **Patriot** and **THAAD** batteries throughout the region (Saudi Arabia, Jordan, Emirates).
- **Coordination with Israel:** Joint attack plans with the IDF to respond instantly to any ballistic missile launch by Tehran or its proxies.

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The Critical Factor: The Strait of Hormuz

The greatest risk remains the possible closure of the **Strait of Hormuz** by Iran. Although the Pentagon has unparalleled mine-clearing and naval escort capabilities, a blockade, even temporary, would cause oil prices to skyrocket, risking global economic stability. This is the most dangerous card in Khamenei's hands, and it is the main obstacle that the "resolver" Trump will have to overcome to complete the operation.

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
