



Italian and Brazilian Army: An Alliance of Strength and Innovation

The year 2025 marks a moment of great importance in the relations between the Italian Army and the Brazilian Army. A significant meeting took place between General of the Army Corps Carmine Masiello, Chief of Staff of the Italian Army, and the Commander of the Brazilian Army, General of the Army Corps Tomás Miguel Miné Ribeiro Paiva, on an official visit to Italy. This meeting marked a moment of dialogue between two armed forces that, although belonging to distant countries, share common values and objectives in ensuring global peace and security. The analysis of this meeting and the prospects for collaboration develops in three main areas: the modernization of the armed forces, interoperability between the two nations, and the historic collaboration in peace missions.

Modernization of the Armed Forces: A Look to the Future

One of the most significant aspects that emerged during the meeting between the two Commanders was the focus on the modernization of the armed forces, with particular attention to the adoption of new technologies and strategies to face modern challenges. The Italian Army presented General Miné Ribeiro Paiva with a briefing on current operations, highlighting how the continuous evolution of technology requires constant modernization of military equipment. The cooperation between Italy and Brazil, therefore, is not limited to exchanges of information and resources but also embraces a concept of strategic development aimed at ensuring that both armies are ready to face future challenges.

In this context, a further example of the modernization of the Brazilian armed forces is represented by the collaboration between the Brazilian Army and IDV (Industria de Defesa Veículos), an important company of the Iveco Group. IDV participated in the LAAD 2025 fair, the largest defense and security event in Latin America, held in Rio de Janeiro from April 1 to 4. The company presented its portfolio of armored vehicles, including the Guarani 6×6 and the Centauro II VBC Cav-MSR 8×8, advanced vehicles chosen by the Brazilian army to enhance its land defense capability. The supply of these armored vehicles is only part of Brazil's strategic plan to modernize its armed force and confirms IDV's commitment to strengthening national defense with innovative solutions.

Interoperability and Cooperation: A Bond Founded on History

The participation of the Brazilian armed forces has had a profound impact on the stabilization of these countries, contributing to the building of a safer and more peaceful world. Brazil's strong commitment to these operations has been globally recognized, and the meeting with the Italian Army offered an opportunity to share experiences, which could further enrich future missions.

Over the years, the Brazilian Army has actively participated in numerous international missions, demonstrating not only its field readiness but also its commitment to promoting peace. The most recent operation was in Haiti, where the Brazilian army provided assistance after the devastating 2010 earthquake. The deployment of over 2,000 soldiers for reconstruction and maintaining order represented a crucial moment in the history of international cooperation.

In the context of this commitment, General Miné Ribeiro Paiva's visit to the Italian Army also represented a reflection on past and future peace missions. The cooperation between the two armies has seen an exchange of experiences on crisis management, the use of resources for humanitarian interventions, and the protection of civilians in conflict scenarios. Global security, in fact, requires that armed forces work together, sharing information, resources, and strategies, to face common threats such as terrorism, natural disasters, and international crime.

A tangible testimony of the cooperation between Brazil and Italy in strengthening land defense capability is the continuous commitment of companies like IDV, which since 2010 has supplied the Brazilian government with numerous armored vehicles, including the Guarani, an amphibious 6×6 vehicle that has become a flagship of the Brazilian army. The partnership with the Brazilian Army has also led to the supply of 420 units of the LMV-BR vehicle, with a contract signed in July 2024 that provides for delivery over a 10-year period.

In summary, the confrontation between the Italian Army and the Brazilian Army is not only an opportunity to strengthen existing cooperation ties but also a fundamental step towards building a more modern and interoperable defense force. The sharing of experiences, knowledge, and technologies between the two armies contributes not only to the growth of each army but also to global security and peace.
