



Open Day 2026 at Morosini: the Naval Military School opens its doors to future Students

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Venice is preparing to welcome students and families for one of the most anticipated events of the school year. With the start of the **Open Day 2026**, the Naval Military School Francesco Morosini opens its doors to future Students, offering three orientation days designed to closely showcase an educational path that combines **academic rigor, nautical tradition, and personal growth**. A concrete opportunity to get to know the Institute, meet those who live it every day, and understand the educational opportunities of a reality that continues to be a reference point in the Italian educational landscape.

The School welcomes students in the last three years of classical and scientific high schools, following ministerial programs and integrating them with a structured educational project, based on **sense of duty, respect for rules, and team spirit**. The Open Days are not just a presentation of the school offer, but a true immersion in collegiate life: an experience that

allows you to closely observe how study, sports, and nautical activities coexist in a balance designed to form conscious citizens, even before future Officers.

Families and young people have the opportunity to interact directly with the permanent staff and with the Students already enrolled in the program, listening to authentic testimonies about daily life at the Institute. It is this direct contact that makes the visit particularly significant, turning it into a first concrete step towards an important choice.

Dates, participation methods, and orientation

To encourage maximum participation, the Open Day 2026 is divided into three appointments distributed between February and March. **Saturday, February 21** and **Saturday, March 14** the Institute opens its gates from 2:30 PM to 5:30 PM for in-person meetings. Guided tours, starting every 30 minutes, allow exploration of classrooms, common areas, sports facilities, and spaces dedicated to nautical training.

Leading the groups are the Students of the 2nd and 3rd Course, who share their study and life experience in the college firsthand, offering an authentic look at the daily dynamics of the School.

Alongside the on-site days, a virtual Open Day is also scheduled for **Saturday, February 28**, divided into a morning and an afternoon session. This mode allows participation even for those who cannot reach Venice, maintaining a direct dialogue with teachers, permanent staff, and students.

For in-person events, no reservation is required, but punctuality is recommended to facilitate the flow of visitors. Alongside the orientation activities, the admission process to the high schools annexed to the School is underway, which includes selection tests and aptitude assessments. A contingent dedicated to new entries is also confirmed for the next school year, a sign of the constant interest in this educational path.

An educational community between study, sports, and values

The Naval Military School “Francesco Morosini” is a true **educational community**, where cultural education is integrated with physical activity and nautical experience. The typical day of the Students alternates school lessons, sports training, and practical activities related to the sea, such as sailing, swimming, rowing, and sculling.

This approach promotes the harmonious development of intellectual and physical abilities, while simultaneously strengthening **autonomy, responsibility, and collaboration**. A particularly significant moment of the path is represented by the experiences at sea and the instructional campaigns, during which students can apply in the field what they have learned in the classroom, experiencing the sea as a learning environment.

In addition, there are official ceremonies, such as the Students' oath, which mark fundamental stages in personal growth and the sense of belonging to the Institute.

The Open Day 2026 thus becomes much more than a simple informative appointment: it is an invitation to discover a reality that combines **tradition and modernity**, rigor and opportunities, offering young people a path capable of preparing them for future challenges with competence and character.

In a constantly evolving educational landscape, Morosini's proposal continues to stand out for its completeness and solidity. Participating in the Open Days means approaching an educational project that focuses on **study, values, and civic sense**, guiding students and families in a conscious and future-oriented choice.
