He also led the [187th Paratrooper Regiment “Folgore”](#) and, between 2017 and 2019, the Paratrooper Brigade “Folgore”.

In addition to his operational assignments, he represented Italy as Military Attaché at the embassy in Washington D.C. and served as Director of the III Department of the General Secretariat of Defense, with particular attention to industrial policy and international relations.
