



Peace or Tragedy: Iran's Crucial Choice after the United States Attack

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On June 22, 2025, the United States, led by President Donald Trump, launched a targeted attack that destroyed Iran's main nuclear sites: Fordow, Natanz, and Esfahan. This intervention was preceded by an Israeli attack on nuclear facilities, but the direct involvement of the United States marked a decisive step in the Middle Eastern crisis. Trump called the operation an "extraordinary success," highlighting the U.S. military superiority in carrying out such a complex and precise action, which involved B-2 stealth bombers and Tomahawk missiles launched from submarines. "All aircraft are now out of Iranian airspace," Trump announced, celebrating the safe return of the aircraft and the effectiveness of the operation.

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The Iranian response was swift: through a message published by the Revolutionary Guards, Tehran declared that "the war has begun." Iran immediately threatened retaliation, including

naval attacks against U.S. forces in the Persian Gulf and the possible closure of the Strait of Hormuz, crucial for global oil trade. Additionally, Iranian forces claimed attacks against Israel, hitting strategic targets such as Ben Gurion Airport and biological research facilities. This episode marks a significant escalation of the conflict, with Iranian forces ready to intensify their military actions in response to the aggression.

The strengthening of alliances and Trump's vision of peace

President Trump used this operation to reaffirm his foreign policy focused on protecting U.S. allies and countering nuclear proliferation. After the attack, Trump stated that the United States does not seek a regime change in Iran, but only the destruction of the country's nuclear capabilities. "Now is the time for peace," he added, issuing an ultimatum to Tehran: the choice between possible diplomatic détente or further attacks. However, Tehran's response highlighted the difficulties in pursuing a peaceful solution, with Iran accusing Washington of violating international law and betraying the ongoing diplomatic process.

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On the international front, Israel fully supported the U.S. action. Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu emphasized the importance of cooperation between the two countries, calling the attack on Iran a necessary step for Israel's security and global stability. The operation eliminated an existential threat to Israel and strengthened the alliance with the United States, demonstrating the strength of strategic cooperation between the two allies. Furthermore, the international community saw the intervention as a decisive move to stop Iran's nuclear program, although some European leaders called for resuming dialogue with Tehran to avoid further escalation of the crisis.

The geopolitical consequences and the future of the conflict

The U.S. attack had immediate repercussions on the stability of the Middle East. While the United States achieved a strategic victory, with Iranian nuclear sites destroyed, Iran threatened "eternal consequences," referring to a possible military escalation involving American bases in the region. The Revolutionary Guards declared that Iranian forces consider U.S. bases in the

region as “legitimate targets” and that Iranian responses will be devastating. The threats include the launch of long-range ballistic missiles and the use of new tactics to bypass American defenses. At the same time, Iran warned that it would not hesitate to launch attacks against Israel and other Western forces in the region, further fueling the risk of a large-scale war.

Despite the escalation, the United States reiterated its willingness to halt military action and initiate negotiations to reach a peaceful solution. Trump confirmed that if Iran chooses peace, the United States will be ready to cooperate, but also made it clear that attacks will continue if the country persists in its aggression. The international community, for its part, is divided: some Western countries justified the intervention as a necessary measure to stop Iran's nuclear program, while others hoped for a resumption of dialogue to avoid direct conflict.

In this uncertain scenario, the situation in the Middle East could evolve rapidly. The possibility of an open war between Iran, the United States, and Israel remains a worrying reality, but at the same time, the U.S. military action could pave the way for a new phase of international negotiations. The United States, while recognizing the serious repercussions of this escalation, continues to maintain its commitment to global security, acting as guardians of peace and stability in a key region for the world's geopolitical future.

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
