The goal? Develop a military version of humanoid robots, specialized in demining, border patrolling, and logistics in war zones.
2. **Compensate for the Recruitment Gap:** If Italians no longer want to take up arms, technology can fill the void. A battalion of robots does not require rest shifts, does not suffer from post-traumatic stress, and can be deployed in hostile environments (chemical, radiological, or high fire risk) without human life costs.

3. **Invest in Digital Sovereignty:** Following the Chinese example of orbital computing, Italy must enhance its satellite infrastructure to ensure that the command and control of its autonomous systems remain inviolable and independent from vulnerable civilian infrastructures.
