



The Paratroopers of the 183rd Nembo Return from Kosovo

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After more than six months of deployment abroad, the [183rd Paratroopers Regiment "Nembo"](#) has officially returned to Pistoia, marking the conclusion of its mission in Kosovo with the return of the War Flag to the "Giovanni Marini" barracks. A moment full of emotion and significance, sealing the contribution of the [Folgore Paratroopers Brigade](#) and the Italian Army to the KFOR operation, the NATO mission aimed at ensuring the security and stability of the Balkans.
