



The Seabed Clearance: The Intervention of the Italian Navy Divers in Civitavecchia

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The sea, a silent guardian of a never fully dormant wartime history, recently returned a dangerous reminder of the past. In the depths of the northern coast of Civitavecchia, in the area known as "La Frasca", a **World War II explosive device** was identified and neutralized, a threat that required the masterful intervention of the **Italian Navy Divers**.

This clearance operation is a tangible demonstration of the high professionalism and efficiency that characterize one of the most specialized corps of our Armed Forces.

The Chronicle of the Operation

It all began on **May 19, 2026**, when the Diving Unit of the Guardia di Finanza of Civitavecchia, during routine operational activities, identified an Italian mine weighing 200 kilograms at about **36 meters deep**. The device, resting on a sandy-muddy seabed and partially concealed by marine encrustations and remnants of fishing nets, posed a concrete risk to the area's safety.

After the prompt report to the Port Authority, which immediately restricted the area to protect navigation and swimming, the intervention protocol of the **Divers of the SDAI (Anti-Insidious Devices Defense Minesweeping) Unit of La Spezia** was activated.

Underwater Safety Professionals: The SDAI Unit

The intervention of the Italian Navy Divers represents the pinnacle of underwater specialization in Italy. The task of clearing explosive devices at sea is one of the most delicate and complex duties, requiring strict protocols:

- **Technical Precision:** Working at 36 meters deep requires not only operational competence but perfect management of underwater physiology and safety procedures.
- **Neutralization:** The Divers secured the device, then proceeded with the delicate transport offshore to suitable areas, where a **controlled detonation** was carried out.
- **Risk Management:** Thanks to constant training and the use of established procedures, the entire operation concluded without issues, ensuring the restoration of safety conditions for the entire coastline.

An Elite Corps at the Service of the Country

The Italian Navy Divers are men trained to operate in prohibitive conditions. Their history is synonymous with **competence, rigor, and dedication**. Whether it is recovering wrecks, conducting complex underwater operations, or, as in this case, freeing our seas from the threat of unexploded ordnance, their work remains a fundamental pillar of national security.

This operation at La Frasca, conducted in perfect synergy between the Guardia di Finanza and the Italian Navy, confirms that the safety of our sea is entrusted to expert personnel, capable of acting swiftly and precisely to protect the community, even dozens of meters below sea level.
